DPN has these concerns concern, beyond the loss of trees, etc:

- Substantial increase in cut-through traffic, not just on Quentin but increasingly through the Promenade mall, to avoid the Rand Road slowdowns, now that the traffic light timing has been changed at Quentin/Rand
- Additional stress at the Long Grove/Quentin intersection, where people create their own right-turn lane to turn east on Long Grove
- Impact of these changes on customer visits to the malls

- Impact of these changes on police traffic protection

? DOOR TO DOOR SCAM

Another neighbor reported a stranger at her door today, claiming to be “out of gas, and I left my credit card at home.” Please think carefully before you open the door or open your wallet, and DO call the non-emergency number to report it. This is a teachable moment to remind children that strangers are a danger even at your own front door.

If this is a scam, we have seen that they commonly work a neighborhood. You might see a car parked somewhere in the subdivision, with a person or persons going door to door. If it’s a strange car, jot down the description and license. Never hurts.

Never hesitate to dial 911; better to make an unnecessary call than no call at all. It’s their job to decide how important an event is.

We always watch out for each other, but during the busy holidays, and with the start of wintry weather, PLEASE REMEMBER TO CLOSE YOUR GARAGE DOORS. That is a very easy point of entry for grab-and-run or—if you happen to be out shoveling snow on your back patio, even bigger losses or personal danger. We regularly count 2-3 dozen garage doors open with lights off any time of day we drive through town.
