

Community Unit School District 95 Attendance Boundary Study Committee Application to Serve

Consolidation from six elementary schools to five elementary schools necessitates the creation of new school attendance boundaries. These will take effect for the 2009-2010 school year.

District residents (including parents, community members, teachers, and support staff) should complete this application if they would like to be considered for membership on the School Attendance Boundary Study Committee. We will attempt to select committee membership in order to have a balanced representation of our entire school community.

This group will develop options for redrawing the attendance boundaries for our elementary and middle schools, ensuring that the adjustments are global in nature with the intent of serving the best interests of all students.

The committee will meet up to four times a month in the evening, and present all viable options to the Superintendent for his review. The Superintendent will consider each option on its own merits. He will then select and make a final recommendation for school attendance boundaries to the Board of Education.
